



### **State, Municipal and Authority Registration/Vehicle Insurance Policy Reporting**

For vehicles registered using State, Municipal or Authority registrations (I.E. they have state, Municipal or Authority registration plates), policy reporting will be optional for insurance carriers. In the infrequent instance where these vehicles are registered using “normal” registration plates, policy reporting will still be required in these cases.

#### Additional Points:

- A report will be sent to state agencies, municipalities and the authorities informing them of the status of all of their registered vehicles
  - As a part of this, we will encourage state agencies, municipalities and the authorities to cancel registrations no longer in use
- Initial (new) state agency, municipal and the authority registrations will continue to require either a self-insured designation or an insurance stamp
- Municipalities and the authorities are still expected to notify the RMV in the event insurance coverage changes for a registered vehicle (Note, the Commonwealth of MA is always self-insured)
- For a carrier to disassociate themselves with a municipal or authority registration, they will be required to add the municipal or authority policy to the registration and subsequently cancel the policy.
- State, municipal and authority registrations will not be included in the policy revocation process or the "no policy" report.
